




Hi! I'm Emmett, a Service Dog in training! I'm learning how to help my human! Here's what I've learned so far!

How Should a Service Dog Behave?


**A Service Dog should

- AND being an invisible ninja!





What Can I Do Around A Service Dog?







How to Ask to Pet a Service Dog

What NOT to Do Around a Service Dog!


STOP

- DON'T bring pets in stores







- Medical alerts







- Is this a Service Dog?


